**Treasurer's Report** - Lynn presented the treasurer's report for March. Beginning balance \$17,248.52. Ending balance \$18,143.52. Available balance after outstanding checks is \$17,361.52.

**Mayor's Update** - Mayor Sharon Zelazny - gearing up for highway project starting May 16. 4 phases. 1st is N. side of 210, E of intersection. Then south side. Then south side by school. Final phase is north side across from school. There will be no parking on the street (210). They are looking to find parking for the post office. Park bids and utility bids will be opened May 17; Council meets May 18. Utilities around town will be addressed; water line under the river to create a loop. The mound near Lippo Lane will be eliminated; will be running sewer lines to that area. The North Alley paving is delayed because the sewer line needs to run under the railroad. The parking lot for the Muni will be paved, along with North alley; South alley will not be redone in this project due to funding. Park renovations will start as soon as possible. Highway 73 closures were discussed. Discussed Highway 73 project 8 miles south of Cromwell. Sen. Jason Rarick, Dan Reed, Jeff Dotseth met at State Capitol and discussed the Highway 73 issues. It is now in the governor's bonding bill as a top priority; DOT has included it in their project list.

### **Old Business:**

**Welcome Baskets** - Kim has drafted the service directory for review by committee.

**Membership Update** - Deb reported there are 37 paid members plus one more paid today.

**MN Sings** - Ann discussed options; no decisions made for the Cromwell event.

**Highway Cleanup** - Scheduled for Saturday, May 7 at 10:30. There are 10-12 people signed up. Will go from intersection and head west. Will not clean the main street due to upcoming construction. Pizza will be served at Pavilion following the clean-up.

**Planters** - Two will be left at Gazebo; the rest will be stored along the wall at the Food Shelf. Possibly plant fall mums later after construction is complete.

### **New Business:**

**Harvest Festival September 9, 10, 11, 2022** - River Hill Rangers tentatively booked for Saturday night; need to clarify with Muni. Discussed live music in afternoon. No parade this year due to difficulties with detours/construction. Suggestion to do a Veterans presentation instead of parade. Lynn asked everyone to think of activities and discuss next month.
